Dear Bret,

On October 13, 2021 a story was published by Let's Go Door County on the social media website Facebook that indicated the former Teweles and Brandeis Grain Elevator, owned by Sturgeon Bay Historical Society Foundation (SBHSF) was going to be moved from the redevelopment site on the City's West Waterfront. The City of Sturgeon Bay and SBHSF have a development agreement that calls for the former grain elevator to be relocated and restored on its original location, this agreement is unchanged, the grain elevator is not being removed from the site.

A surface parking lot is planned for the west waterfront redevelopment site, this lot will serve the adjacent developments including the public parkland spaces, waterfront promenade, grain elevator, restaurant, and apartment building. Siting the grain elevator at its historic location is not impacted by the surface parking lot, parkland improvements or any other development.

Attached is a depiction of the West Waterfront area showing the final location of the grain elevator, approximate configuration of the public parking lot, public parkland improvements and locations and footprints of the apartment and restaurant developments.
