

WORK UNDERWAY at the GRAIN ELEVATOR - February 2024



Work has begun in earnest on Phase II of the Door County Granary. The addition, located on the elevator's west side, is taking shape. It is architecturally designed and situated to pay homage to the train cars that once serviced the Teweles and Brandeis Grain Elevator. It will house public restrooms open to all who visit the West Waterfront and a catering kitchen for events. Construction crews will soon begin to repair the 19 grain bins on the elevator's second floor and install siding reclaimed from the Globe Grain Elevator in Superior, Wisconsin.
